Schedule 4 | Pest-control requirements

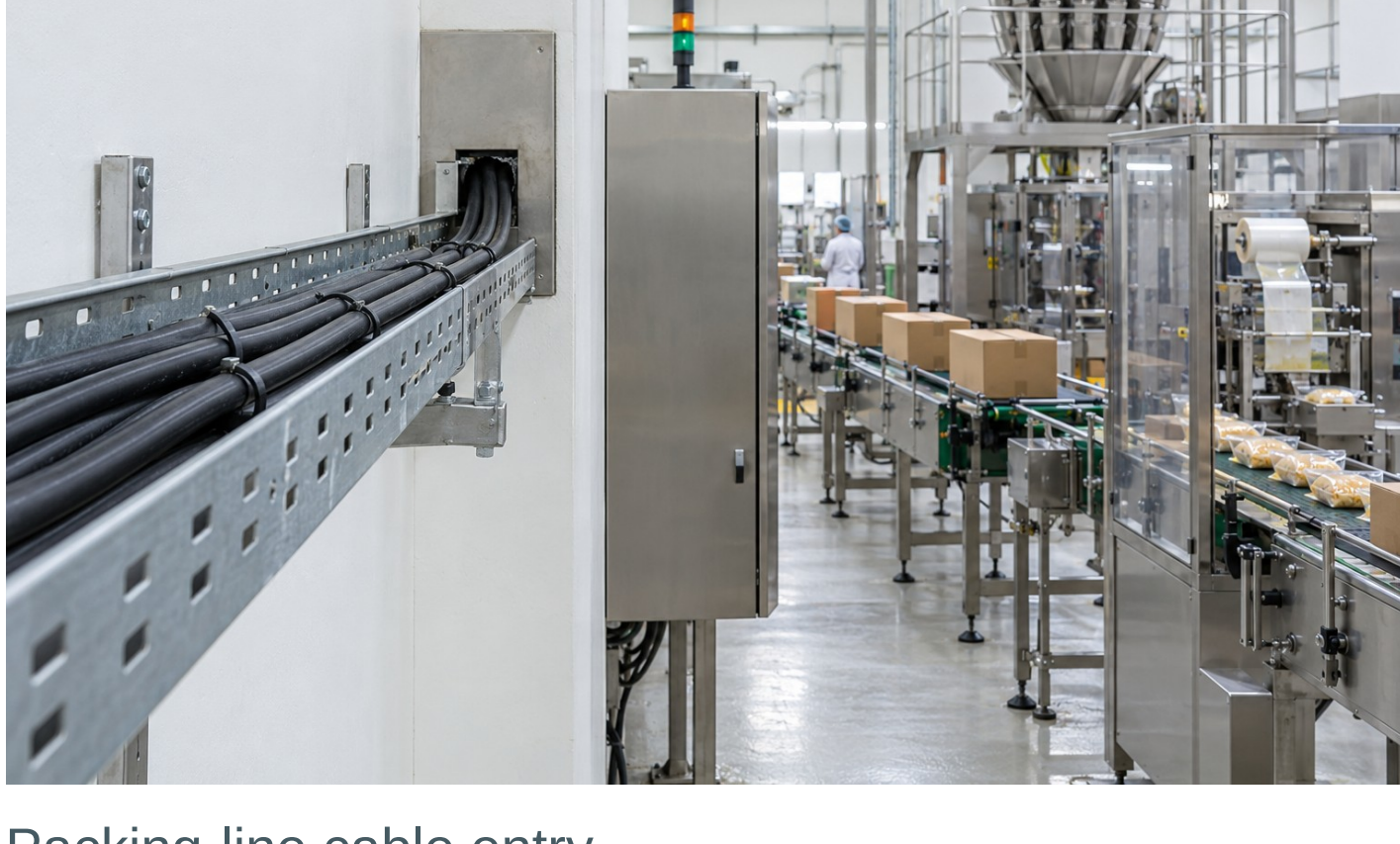
Block entry. Act on infestation.

Keep pest-control records.

ONE RAT BITE. A FOOD LINE AT RISK.

Protect the cables behind production,

packing and cold storage.



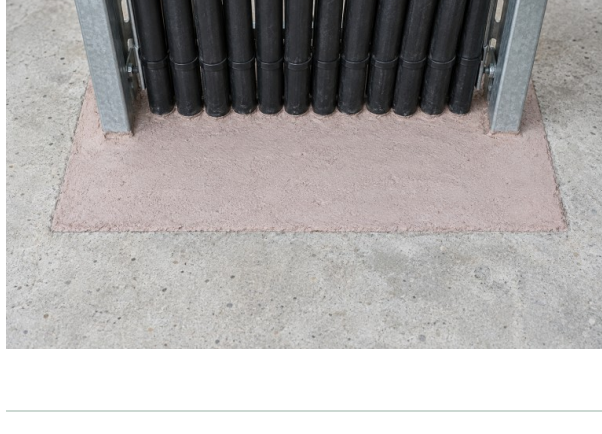
Packing-line cable entry.

A chewed cable can stop packing or refrigeration. Damaged stock and delayed dispatch cost far more than the cable.

CLOSE THE WAY IN.

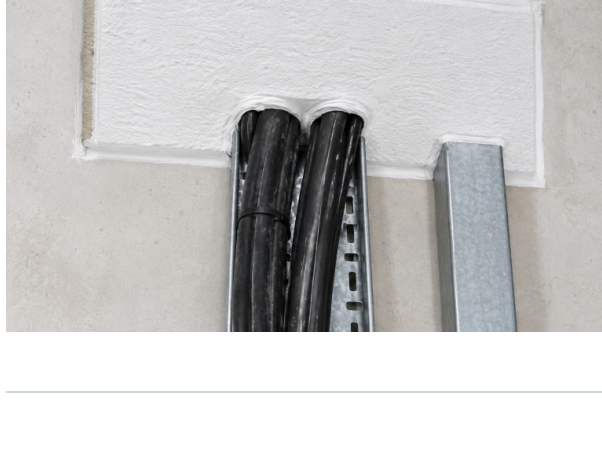
Choose by opening and future cable access.

Firestop mortar.

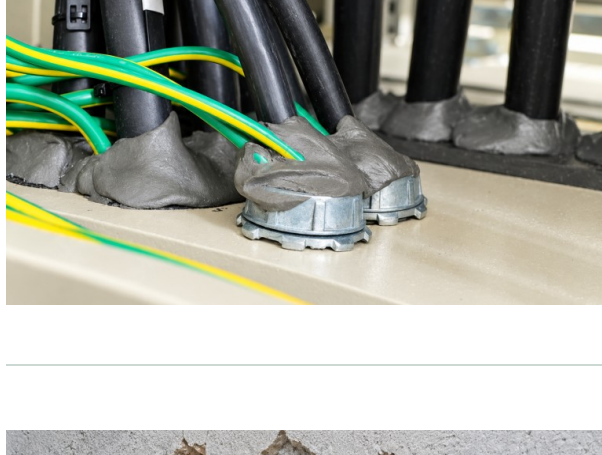
Rigid seal for large wall and floor openings.



FB 250

Mineral-wool board.

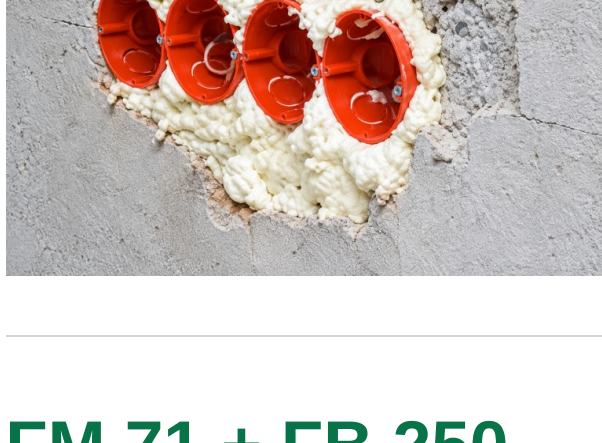
Re-open the seal for future cable changes.



FBS 73

Flexible firestop putty.

Mould around small gaps and panel entries.



Z201 PUFSEAL

Self-expanding foam.

Fill general non-rated gaps and cavities.

FM 71 + FB 250

Combined mortar and board firestop for wall and floor openings.

Use the tested firestop build. Coat compatible exposed seal faces with EC 7034.

FIREX EC 7034

Translucent, flexible anti-rodent and fire-protective cable coating.



Coating fixed cable sheaths.

CHOOSE THE CABLE BUILD

Fixed cables + panel wiring

EC 7034: 4 coats, about 1.5 mm total dry film.

Essential fire-survival routes

Retain specified EC 43 Survival build. Add EC 7034: minimum 2 coats / 0.5 mm topcoat.

Apply to QA-approved non-food-contact surfaces after electrical isolation. Keep pest checks, cleaning and entry repairs in place.

SEAL THE ENTRY. KEEP FOOD MOVING.

Send photos of your cable entries.

Ask for a site review and quotation.

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
